The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973 for issuing direction to respondents No.2 & 3 i.e Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar City and Station House Officer, Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar respectively, to afford a personal hearing to the petitioner to explain and produce all the relevant documents in view of the complaint (Annexure P-1) which is filed for registration of case against private respondents No.4 to 10.

Today, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Status report has been filed.

Considering the prayer of the petitioner, the petitioner is

allowed to produce all the documents before the police. However, this Court cannot issue direction to police to register the FIR. It is for the police to see whether on the basis of document some cognizable offence is made out or not and then take appropriate action accordingly.

However, if the petitioner is not satisfied with the police action, he is at liberty to approach the Illaqa Magistrate along with appropriate complaint and appropriate prayer, since the police in the reply denied the receipt of any complaint.
