1. Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to get FIR No.47 dated 16.03.2018 under Sections 336/430/506/34 IPC, 25/27 of Arms Act and 3 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984, registered at Police Station Sadar, Jalalabad, District Fazilka, investigated from Crime Branch or any other Senior Officer.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, if respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Fazilka, is directed to decide representation dated 25.07.2018 (Annexure P-7), moved by the petitioners.

3. In view of the above, respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Fazilka, is directed to look into the matter and decide representation 25.07.2018 (Annexure P-7), moved by the petitioners himself in accordance with law, without seeking any report or referring the same to his office subordinate on merit, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to them, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. He would not be prejudiced by any report or inquiry got conducted by any officer subordinate under his order.

4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
