Instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR NO. 610 dated 18.08.2018 under Section 11/59/60 of The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 and Section 13(2) of The Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015, registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal, Palwal.

Perusal of the documents it is evident that petitioner is also involved earlier in FIR No. 325 dated 18.05.2016 under Sections 3,4,5,6 and 7 of Illegal Profession Act registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal. It seems that petitioner is habitual offender. Therefore, he is not entitled to anticipatory bail as sought by the petitioner in the present petition for the offences punishable under Section 11, 59, 60 of The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 and Section 13(2) of The Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015.

With the above observation petition stands dismissed.
