In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.0134 dated 22.06.2018, under Sections 420 and 511 IPC registered at Police Station North (Sector 3), District Chandigarh.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is in custody since June, 2018 and alleged allegation is relating to certain Bank transaction which are resulted in fraud and cheating.

3. On instructions of SI Vijay Kumar learned State counsel submitted that he is not involved in any other case.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

4. In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner that he is not involved in any other case and he is in custody since June, 2018 and disposal of the trial will take sufficient time, I deem it appropriate

to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

5. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Piyush is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.

6. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

7. Petition stands allowed.
