Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case, being one of 50 to 60 persons who are stated to have gone on a rampage and caused damage at Railway Station Kalayat, in protest against the conviction of Gurmeet Ram Rahim Singh.

He submits that otherwise also the contention that the station was attacked by 50 to 60 people and a damage of only Rs.11000/- to Rs.12000/- was caused, would not be wholly believable.

Though learned State counsel opposes the bail petition, however, without making any comment on the petitioners' involvement or non-involvement in the crime, seeing the fact that he has been in custody for a period of 4½ months as is not denied by learned State counsel (on instructions), and the damage to the property is stated to be Rs.12000/-, with the trial still at the initial stage itself, I consider it appropriate to admit the

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petitioner to bail, upon furnishing his bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
