Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pursuant to the order dated 13.10.2017, petitioner has effectively joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh objected the prayer made by petitioner for the grant of anticipatory bail by submitting that petitioner is the author of grievous injuries. Injuries No.1 and 2 were found on the left parietal side of head of the complainant and were described to be grievous in nature as per opinion given by the Board of Doctors.

As against this learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that no fracture was found as per X-ray report.

At this state without commenting anything on the assertions made on either side, I deem it appropriate to confirm the interim order dated 13.10.2017. Ordered accordingly. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Officer.

Petition stands disposed of.
