Report filed by the State that marriage of the brother of the petitioner is fixed for 21.9.2018. However, two other cases under Excise Act are pending against the petitioner. Police reported that if the petitioner is released on interim bail, it will create law and order problem and danger to drive against drugs.

Considering that attending the marriage of the brother by the petitioner is merely wish of the petitioner, I am of the view that considering that three cases are pending against the petitioner, he is not to be allowed interim bail.

Resultantly, the present petition stands dismissed.
