Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.28 dated 01/05/2018, registered under Sections 376/363/366-A/420/120-B of IPC and Sections 4/8 of POCSO Act at Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is the Uncle and the main allegations are against Bachhittar Singh and allegations in the FIR are that Bachhittar Singh has enticed the daughter of the complainant and the maternal Uncle lives in the same village. Counsel further submits that anticipatory bail had been allowed to Sahib Singh and Gurpreet Kaur.

Challan has been presented. The case is fixed for framing of charge. Petitioner is the maternal Uncle of the boy. The allegation against him is under Section 120-B IPC.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
