The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 28.09.2017 (Annexure P-7), passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal in Criminal Revision No.119 of 2017 dated 23.08.2017, in which the revision petition filed by the petitioner has been dismissed in case FIR No.227 dated 27.06.2017 under Sections 379, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Madhuban.

On instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, learned State counsel states that as per report received from Laboratory, 131 drums Tarchol, two drums black oil and five bags of white chuna powder were not found to be adulterated. Police is going to be present cancellation report. Police has no objection if 131 drums Tarchol, two drums black oil and five bags of white chuna powder are released to the petitioner.

It being so, articles mentioned above, be released to the petitioner against proper receipt.

Accordingly, petition is allowed.
