The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.326 dated 18.12.2015, registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 506, 120-B IPC, at Police Station City Khanna, District Ludhiana.

It has been submitted that the petitioner was an agent of a company i.e. '4 S Forever Private Limited' but he has denied any relation with that company.

The petitioner has been arrested in this case on 19.05.2018. The challan has already been submitted and the co-accused have already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 12.07.2017 in Criminal Misc.Nos.17819 and 18976 of 2017. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long

time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Darshan Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
