The petitioner-Bintu son of Sh. Baljit Singh, seeks regular bail in FIR No.143, dated 18.06.2018 registered at Police Station Agroha, District Hisar, under sections 114, 115, 147, 148, 307, 323, 324, 328, 506 IPC and section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (section 326 IPC added later on).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 18.07.2018. The investigation is complete but the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as charges have not been framed as yet. The petitioner was not named in the FIR and has been involved on the supplementary statement. The injury declared dangerous to life is not attributed to the petitioner. There is no other criminal case pending/decided against him and thus, he may be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel opposes the prayer on the ground that the petitioner, being a part of mob, could have also inflicted the injury declared dangerous to life. It is however, admitted by him that no sharp-edged weapon was recovered from the petitioner. He admits that the investigation is complete but charges have not been framed as yet. On enquiry regarding the criminal antecedents of the petitioner, it is admitted that there is no other criminal case pending/decided against him.

Keeping in view the fact that only simple injuries are attributed to the petitioner and that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as well as the fact that the petitioner does not have criminal antecedents, it would be just and appropriate to release him on regular bail.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the petitioner- Bintu son of Sh. Baljit Singh, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court concerned.
