LISA GILL, J

Learned counsel for petitioners seeks to withdraw this petition for quashing of complaint No. 39/15 dated 10.04.2010, summoning order dated 21.09.2011 and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom. However, it is submitted that petitioner no.1 is the married sister-in-law of the complainant and is living separately with her in-laws family. She had earlier filed CRM-M-32357 of 2014 for the same relief which was dismissed on 18.09.2014 on the ground of order dated 21.09.2011 being a revisable order. A limited prayer is addressed at this stage that exemption from personal appearance be afforded to petitioner no.1.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, it is directed that petitioner no.1 be afforded exemption from personal appearance subject to the conditions that the petitioner:-

- i. shall be represented through counsel;
- ii. shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- iii. shall not dispute her identity as accused;
- iv. shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in her absence but in the presence of her counsel;
- v. shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the Trial Court;
- vi. any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.
