The petitioner prays for issuance of appropriate directions to official respondents to take necessary action against respondent No.5 especially on the basis of his representation dated 23.7.2018 (Annexure P-6). The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that respondent No.5, who is running a travel agency had held out an assurance to the petitioner that he would send the petitioner and his wife on couple visa to USA and demanded ₹ 20 lacs and that the petitioner having been taken in by said representation gave an amount of ₹ 6.67 lacs on various occasions, some of which were deposited in his bank account. It has been submitted that despite a representation dated 23.7.2018 (Annexure P-6) having been made to the police, no action has been taken thereupon against respondent No.5.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-The Superintendent of Police, Karnal, District Karnal to look into the matter and to dispose of the

representation (Annexure P-6) dated 23.7.2018 (although addressed to Inspector General of Police, Karnal), moved by petitioner, expeditiously in accordance with law. In case the allegations contained therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law. A copy of this order alongwith representation (Annexure P-6) dated 23.7.2018 be sent to respondent No.3-The Superintendent of Police, Karnal, District Karnal so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
