The petitioner prays for issuance of necessary directions to official respondents to protect his life and property from the hands of private respondents No.8 to 15.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although a report vide General Dairy No.20 dated 21.2.2018 had been recorded by the police but necessary action has not been taken thereupon. The learned counsel submits that the private respondents had earlier given beatings to wife of the petitioner on 27.9.2015 and upon medical examination MLR had also been recorded. It has further been submitted that subsequently on 8.2.2018 the private respondents abused the wife of the petitioner and recently the private respondents gave beatings to the petitioner and to his mother. It has been submitted that despite the fact that several representations dated 5.10.2015, 8.2.2018, 15.2.2018, 30.4.2018 and 30.4.2018 (Annexures P-1, P-3, P-7, P-9 and P-10 respectively) had been submitted to official respondents, no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the matter and to consider the representations dated 5.10.2015, 8.2.2018, 15.2.2018, 30.4.2018 and 30.4.2018 (Annexures P-1, P-3, P-7, P-9 and P-10 respectively), moved by petitioner, expeditiously preferably within a period of four months from today in accordance with law. In case the allegations contained therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law. It is further directed that the matter pertaining to General Dairy No.20 dated 21.2.2018 be also enquired into fairly and expeditiously. A copy of this order alongwith representations dated 5.10.2015, 8.2.2018, 15.2.2018, 30.4.2018 and 30.4.2018 (Annexures P-1, P-3, P-7, P-9 and P-10 respectively) be sent to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
