Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing of order dated 14.01.2014 (Annexure p-6) passed by Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula in case FIR No.156 dated 09.11.2012, under Sections 420, IPC & 24 of Immigration Act, 1983 registered at Police Station Sector 14, Panchkula (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of affidavit in the shape of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between them.

Vide order dated 28.09.2018, parties were directed to appear before the Trial Court for recording their statement qua compromise between them and the trial court was directed to report as to whether compromise between them is genuine, without any pressure or undue influence and also whether any accused was declared as proclaimed offender. Vide letter No.535 dated 29.10.2018, Judicial

Magistrate Ist Class, Panchkula duly forwarded by District and Sessions Judge, Panchkula vide letter No.4133-J dated 30.10.2018 has reported that compromise between the parties is genuine, without any pressure or undue influence and in favour of the parties to live with peace and harmony.

Considering the above report and compromise between the parties and the fact that compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, aforesaid FIR No.156 dated 9.11.2012 and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, is quashed qua petitioners, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- out of which Rs.4000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana High Court, Rs.1000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs.5000/- with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Legal Services Committee within one week from today, failing which the petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.

Disposed of accordingly.
