By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to initiate action on her representation/complaint dated 4.7.2018 (Annexure P-7).

The learned counsel has submitted that despite the fact that respondent No.4 had cut valuable trees standing on his property, and despite the fact that an application had been submitted by the petitioner to the police, no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation/complaint dated 4.7.2018 (Annexure P-7), moved by petitioner, expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from today in accordance with law. In case the allegations contained therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law. A copy of this order alongwith representation/

complaint dated 4.7.2018 (Annexure P-7) be sent to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
