Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the order dated 4.7.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned JMIC, Chandigarh in complaint No. 6662/2016 and for allowing the application dated 16.5.2018 (Annexure P-5) moved by petitioner for examining the handwriting expert to take sample/specimen of the petitioner-accused as well as the complainant.

A perusal of the impugned order shows that petitioner has admitted signatures on the cheque. The body was filled in by someone else.

Learned trial Court has taken a view that there is no need of examination of expert.

After going through the record, I am of the view that since the petitioner has admitted his signatures on the cheque, he is always at liberty to raise all pleas that the body of cheque was filled in by some body else.

No ground to interfere in the impugned order is made out.

Dismissed.
