In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.09 dated 06.07.2018 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Talwandi Bhai, District Ferozepur.

2. Petitioner while entering into an agreement in respect of sale of 3 kanals 8 marlas 5 sarsai land received a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- on 24.7.2017 and failed to execute the sale deed dated 31.01.2018. At the same time on 20.02.2018, petitioner is stated to have executed agreement with one Sarabjit Singh in respect of 2 kanals of land. Prima facie, it is evident that intention of the petitioner is to cheat the complainant. Therefore, petitioner has not made out a case to seek anticipatory bail.

4. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
