This is a petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 113 dated 8.8.2018, under Sections 365, 379-A, 384, 385, 388, 389, 506, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act 1959, registered at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa.

Petitioner is alleged to be one of the persons who kidnapped Dishant son of the complainant. Thereafter, ransom was demanded. Petitioner has been named in the statement of the victim recorded under Section 161 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. A gun was also used for kidnapping.

Since the offence is of serious nature and requires thorough investigation and for which petitioner is also required for custodial interrogation, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the present petitioner.
