Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.63 dated 11.08.2018 under Section 61 of the Excise Act, 1914 registered at Police Station Shahpurkandi, District Pathankot.

The order dated 27.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Pathankot reveals that the application seeking anticipatory bail of the petitioner was dismissed on the ground that the petitioner is involved in certain other cases of similar nature.

Therefore, this Court finds that the petitioner does not deserve the benefit of anticipatory bail and accordingly, the present petition, being devoid of any merit, is dismissed.
