In the instant petition, petitioners have sought for regular bail in case FIR No.185 dated 18.07.2018, under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1).

- (i) Petitioners shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and they shall not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.
