In the instant petition, petitioner has prayed for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 213 dated 28.06.2018 registered at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala for the offence punishable under Section 174-A of IPC.

Perusal of the records, it is evident that petitioner has been declared as Proclaimed Offender on 16.08.2017. Whereas this court has stayed Proclaimed Offender order dated 27.06.2018 (His arrest has been stayed). Thereafter, seeking anticipatory bail do not arise in view of the stay of his arrest. Therefore, petitioner has approached this court prematurely seeking for anticipatory bail. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach this court as and when fresh cause of action accrues, if any.
