Although the present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to lodge an FIR under Sections 302 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 against the private respondents but the learned counsel restricts his prayer for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to consider his representation Annexure P-6 expeditiously.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 4.6.2018 (Annexure P-6), moved by petitioner, expeditiously preferably within a period of two months from today in accordance with law. In case the allegations contained therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law. A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 4.6.2018 (Annexure P-6) be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
