Today, at the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the trial Court for moving appropriate application in this regard.

Since, during the course of arguments, the learned counsel submitted that infact he was arrayed as an accused in FIR No.80 dated 16.11.2009 registered under Sections 324, 353, 186, 332 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Bhadaur, District Barnala but somehow the said file was consigned when the connected case arising out of FIR No.79 dated 15.11.2009 registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 was consigned and that although he had moved an application for getting proceedings initiated against himself before the trial Court with a prayer for tracing the file but the said file could not be traced and ultimately the said application was dismissed for non-prosecution.

If the aforesaid facts are correct, the trial Court shall do the needful for getting the file traced and for initiating the requisite proceedings.

The present petition is disposed of as withdrawn with aforesaid direction to the trial Court. A copy of this order be sent to the trial Court concerned so as to do the needful.
