While passing a detailed order on 18.04.2018, the petitioner was directed to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court .

In view of earlier order passed on 05.02.2018, learned State counsel submits that the veracity of the bills has been verified and the same have been found to be genuine.

Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The interim order passed by this Court on 18.04.2018 is made absolute.

However, it is made clear that the allegations levelled in the FIR are the matter of evidence which shall be taken into consideration by the trial Court during trial.
