This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Section 22B Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, vide FIR No.142 dated 28.5.2014.

According to prosecution, 200 grams of intoxicant powder was recovered from the possession of the accused. During the trial, he absented from the proceedings. As a result, the bail bonds were cancelled and surety bonds were forfeited.

In view of the conduct of the petitioner and the fact that Section 37 of the Act is attracted, this petition is without any merit and is hereby dismissed.
