Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in DDR No.34 dated 19.08.2017 under Sections 452, 325, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC recorded in FIR No.80 dated 13.08.2017 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Maqboolpura, District Amritsar.

Further prayer for directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family at the hands of private respondents and to add the relevant Section in the FIR i.e. Sections 295-A and 326 IPC has also been made.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to expedite the investigation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without making any observation on the claim so projected by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to expedite the investigation in the aforementioned DDR as well as the FIR.
