Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No. 56, dated 13.08.2018, under Sections 420, 120-B, IPC, Section 10 of Immigration Act and Section 13 of Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012, registered at Police Station, Thulliwal, District Barnala (Annexure P-1) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 27.8.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant states that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, from ASI Harjinder Singh, states that the police has prepared a cancellation report and the

same has been duly approved by the SSP, Barnala and is likely to be

filed within one month before the trial court.

In view of the fact that the police has prepared a cancellation report and the same is in the process of being filed before the Illaqa Magistrate, the present petition is rendered infructuous at this stage.

However, the police is directed to submit the cancellation report within a period of one month from today. In case, the said report is not submitted in the court within the period so directed or if the same is not accepted by the Illaqa Magistrate, the petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival of the present petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
