Petitioners Kaku Singh and Pushpinder Singh have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest in FIR No.116 dated 04.08.2018 under Sections 353 and 186 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 13.09.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Kulwant Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and

the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 13.09.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
