The allegations in this petition are that the petitioner got married with respondent No.4 on 30.03.2013 and after few years difference between them led to a matrimonial dispute. Now, respondent No.4 as well as her family members are threatening the petitioner. Despite representation dated 28.08.2018 (Annexure P5), no action has been taken by the police.
