The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.94 dated 02.09.2017, registered under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 IPC and Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, at Police Station City 2 Abohar, Tehsil Abohar, District Fazilka.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Balbir Singh Belt No.539, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 20.10.2017 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
