Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.121 dated 12.11.2015, registered under Sections 302, 341, 323, 34, 147, 149 IPC at Police Station Rori, District Sirsa.

This is a murder case and direct evidence is against the petitioner. PW2 Jasbir Singh in his statement before the Court has submitted that the petitioner alongwith his associates armed with deadly weapon had belayed the deceased and inflicted injuries to him.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the x-ray report, it has been shown that some radio opaque (Pellets) shadows were seen in the thigh of the deceased.

To the mind of this Court, this is not the stage to criticize or appreciate the evidence.

However, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the role attributed to the petitioner and also the facts that the trial is in progress and all the material witnesses have been examined, no ground to grant the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed.
