Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rupinder Singh who is present in Court to assist her, does not dispute the fact that an interim order has been passed in civil proceedings, ordering *status quo* qua the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has further produced in Court today, an order of the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana, dated 01.12.2017, restraining the complainant in this FIR, i.e. Manjit Singh (defendant no. 2 in the civil suit), as also the Punjab State Power Corporation, from causing any hindrance in the peaceful and lawful usage of the electric connection in question by the applicants, i.e. the first two petitioners herein, i.e. Pritpal Singh and Jagmohan Singh.

That being so, the order of this Court dated 16.10.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
