Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.232 dated 07.06.2016, registered at Police Station Sushant Lok, District Gurugram, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been

got recorded by complainant-Sudesh. As per the allegations, Rajiv Kumar

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was having good relations with the family of the complainant, who went to foreign country and gave general power of attorney, signed cheque book, blank signed documents to Rajiv Kumar. Rajiv Kumar is the main accused, who misappropriated the property and money of the complainant. The allegation against the present petitioner is only in respect of criminal conspiracy and connivance.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 18.08.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 18.08.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
