Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.125 dated 12.07.2016 under Sections 420, 201, 193, 177, 120-B IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Division No.4, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

On 14.09.2018, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was facing the trial, however, on account of noting a wrong date as 30.05.2018 instead of 03.04.2018, he could not appear before the trial Court and his bail/surety bonds were forfeited and non-bailable warrants have been issued. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court and apply for fresh bail.

Notice of motion for 12.10.2018. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in

pursuance to the orders dated 14.09.2018 and 10.10.2018, has appeared before the trial Court and has been granted interim bail. It is further submitted that the petitioner has also paid the cost of Rs. 10,000/- and he will appear before the trial Court on subsequent dates also.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 14.09.2018 is made absolute.
