**ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)**

The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 27 dated 07.03.2014, under Sections 420 and 406 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

The operative part of the order dated 14.09.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

**“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the complainant has filed the complaint primarily against the parents of the petitioner i.e. Darshan Singh and Smt. Deepo. It is further submitted that even the petitioner along with son of the complainant had tried to illegally enter USA and thereafter, they were deported back. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that there is no direct allegation against the petitioner of handing over an alleged amount of Rs.30.00 lacs. It is also submitted that co-accused Darshan Singh was granted regular bail and is facing the trial and at one point of time,**

**other co-accused Smt. Deepo was declared proclaimed offender, however, she was summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. and is on anticipatory bail.**

**Notice of motion for 03.12.2018.”**

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 14.09.2018, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Shalender Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 14.09.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
