Petitioner Mandeep Singh @ Amritpal has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.85 dated 24.03.2018, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa, under Section 379-B of IPC.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the FIR has been registered on the statement of complainant-Mangat Singh. As per the prosecution version, four boys gave beating to the complainant and took his purse from back pocket of his pant, containing ₹4000/-, driving license, ATM Card and Aadhaar Card.

The petitioner has been in custody since 24.03.2018. He is not

custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
