Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.258 dated 12.05.2018, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 365, 406, 506 & 120-B of IPC at Police Station City Gohana, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner Sneha is neighbour of the victims and the statements given by the girls under Section 161 Cr.P.C. and under Section 164 Cr.P.C. have been placed on file and the girls did not make any allegations of rape and they had refused their medical and challan has been presented and the charge has been framed.

In the statement given under Section 164 Cr.P.C., victim had stated that she had taken some money from her house and the petitioner had given sleeping pills to her family and they were taken to Alwar and Jaipur and then to Gurgaon and stayed in a Gurudwara. Later they went to

Ahmedabad and stayed there for 2 days. In the statement made under Section 161 Cr.P.C., one of the victims had disclosed in her statement Annexure P-1 that the petitioner was her sister-in-law and Kashish was the brother-in-law of Sneha and all of them had gone together and they had taken money and jewellery from the Almirah of their own house and they travelled to different places. They were never left alone and when their money had finished, they sold the ring and they were detained and were threatened.

The victims were traveling to different places with the petitioner and her brother-in-law. No allegations of rape have been levelled. Investigation is already over.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
