It is contended that petitioner No.1 – Jaspreet Kaur, aged about 23 years has got married with petitioner No.2- Ashvi Kumar, aged about 25 years, against the wishes of her parents, who are arrayed as private respondents No.4 to 7 and they have been trying to interfere in their marital life, as such to seek protection in that regard, they have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – The Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the grievances of the petitioners and to take necessary measures to ensure that lives and

liberty of the petitioners are not jeopardized at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 or persons claiming under them.

However, this order shall not validate the marriage between the petitioners and shall not have any effect on any civil or criminal action to which the petitioners may be found liable, under the law.
