Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
has been made for quashing FIR No.58, dated 28.12.2015,
registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148 & 149 IPC and
Sections 308, 325 IPC added lateron, at Police Station Taragarh,
Tehsil and District Pathankot and all other consequential
proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

2. Pursuant to order dated 17.09.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate on 08.10.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Additional Sessions Judge, Pathankot, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.560, dated 12.10.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Pathankot, vide letter No.2876 dated 13.10.2018.

3. According to the report, learned Additional Sessions Judge, Pathankot, is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is with the intervention of respectables of the Gram Panchayat members, without any pressure, coercion and with their free will.

4. Considering the report of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Pathankot, dated 12.10.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.58, dated 28.12.2015, registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148 & 149 IPC and Section 308, 325 IPC added lateron, at Police Station Taragarh, Tehsil and District Pathankot, is quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹6,000/- shall be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority and ₹4,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana High Court.

5. Petition is disposed of accordingly.
