Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.84 dated 22.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Section 392 IPC registered at Police Station Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana.

Earlier also, the petitioner had approached this Court by way of CRM-M-32223-2018 and the said petition was dismissed as withdrawn on 06.08.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that no recovery was effected from the petitioner.

However, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajinderpal Singh, has controverted the aforesaid fact and has

submitted that it is on the basis of disclosure statement of the petitioner, 7 bags of threads and one stick (*danda*) have been recovered.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that apart from the earlier petition having been dismissed as withdrawn, there is disclosure statement made by the petitioner, which led to recovery of 7 bags of threads and one stick (*danda*), no ground for grant of bail is made out.
