Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that now the matter has been compromised between the parties, which learned counsel for the complainant does not deny.

Though learned counsel for the State has no instructions as regards the compromise reached, however, learned counsel for the complainant having admitted to the compromise and this being a petition seeking 'regular bail' for the petitioner (not quashing of the FIR), the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
