In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for the following relief:-

“Petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to transfer the investigation to some other District or to the Crime Department or to some other independent agency in FIR No.0106 dated 14.07.2018 under Sections 408, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC, Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-1) as the investigating officer is working in collusion with the private respondents.”

2.) Petitioner is relying on Annexure P-2 representation which is stated to have been given to the ADGP, Crime Branch, Chandigarh. Perusal of the pleadings/statement with reference to FIR No.0106 dated 14.07.2018, the allegations stated are too vague and not supported by any dates and

events. In the absence of specific dates and events, the ADGP Crime cannot act upon the petitioner's representation.

3.) Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out that petitioner's representation has been forwarded to the Senior Superintendent of Police to look into the grievance of the petitioner. Even Senior Superintendent of Police's hands are tied for taking any action on the petitioner's representation in the absence of specific allegations against the contesting respondents with reference to dates and events so as to ascertain from the contesting respondents. Therefore, petitioner has not made out a case.

4.) Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to make one more effective representation. If such effective representation is made, in that event, concerned police official is hereby directed to take necessary action.
