DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 21.09.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is only the attesting witness. No active role has been played by him. The main accused has been arrested. Learned counsel also submits that co-accused, namely, Aasin Khan has also been released on interim bail which has been made absolute vide order dated 13.11.2018 passed today in **CRM-M No.23252 of 2018**.

Learned State counsel has affirmed the factum of joining investigation, on instructions from ASI Sube Singh.

Learned counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that there are serious allegations of depositing the amount in the account and thereafter its withdrawal in connivance with co-accused. The said

amount which was withdrawn might be received by the petitioner.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation; he is not required as submitted by learned State counsel; co-accused has been released on anticipatory bail, which has been made absolute and the main accused has been arrested, interim order passed in favour of the petitioner on 21.09.2018 is made absolute.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
