The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.47 dated 25.05.2016, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Sector 17, Chandigarh.

During the pendency of the instant petition, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this court. The parties have compromised the matter and a Settlement Agreement dated 16.11.2018 has come into effect wherein, the parties have decided to reside together as husband and wife in the matrimonial home.

In view of the facts that the matter stands compromised between the parties, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the

case, the petition is allowed and order dated 17.09.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
