MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J. (Oral)

1. The petition is filed praying for quashing FIR No.75 dated 7.4.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar, on the basis of compromise entered into between the parties.

2. Heard.

3. Both the parties were directed by this Court vide order dated 25.10.2017 to appear before the learned trial Court and get their statements recorded and in pursuance thereof, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nakodar having recorded the statements of both the parties submitted a report dated 16.12.2017. A perusal of the same reveals that the compromise entered into between the parties is voluntary and without any pressure or coercion.

4. Inasmuch as the dispute between the parties has been amicably settled and they have already entered into compromise, continuance of the prosecution would be an exercise in futility. Therefore, the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings resulting therefrom are quashed.
5. Petition is allowed.
