ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.0058 dated 08.05.2018, registered under Sections 120-B, 363, 366-A, 376 of IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act, 2012 at Police Station Dhand, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the main allegations are against Ajay brother of the petitioner and the allegations are that both of them had taken the girl away. Counsel further submits that perusal of the FIR would show that the only allegation against the petitioner is that he was pressurizing the girl to run away and challan has been presented.

The main allegation against the petitioner is that he has assisted his brother who had eloped with the prosecutrix, who was a minor.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
