Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.71 dated 27.05.2018, registered under Sections 323, 452 & 506 of IPC and Sections 8/16 of the POCSO Act, 2012 at Police Station Barara, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is the sister-in-law of the complainant and the allegations against her are that she was forcing her to speak to Jony. Counsel further submits that Jony is married and he is not related to the petitioner and the petitioner is the member of the Gram Panchayat and the father of the complainant is Chowkidar of the village and was nursing grudge against her and she had been named.

Learned State counsel states that challan has been presented.

Investigation is over. The main accused is Jony who had confined the girl and had molested her.

Trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
