The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case registered vide FIR No.127 dated 18.06.2018 under Sections 341, 379-B/34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 323 & 427 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 added later on) registered at Police Station Bond Kalan, District Charkhi Dadri.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Amit Kumar son of Jagbir Singh, who alleged that on 17.06.2018 when he was going home on his Scorpio vehicle and reached near village Uan, then 3-4 boys stopped his vehicle and scuffled with him and snatched his wallet containing ₹27,000/-, which also contained other documents including

AADHAR card, licence, PAN Card etc. It has further been stated therein that the said boys belonged to the village of the complainant are named as Rahul, Deepak, Sachin and Amit son of Sanjay.

Notice of this petition was issued to the respondent-State.

Learned counsel has submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case due to party faction in the village. It has further been submitted that in any case, the challan has already been presented and the petitioner is no longer required for investigation.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has submitted that in view of the fact that serious allegations has been levelled against the petitioner, therefore, he is not entitled for the concession of bail. It has further been informed that the challan has already been presented in the trial Court on 24.08.2018 and the petitioner is not involved in any other identical case.

Having considered the rival submissions addressed before this Court and bearing in mind that the challan has already been presented, in my opinion, no fruitful purpose would be served by further detaining the petitioner behind bars. Accordingly, petitioner-Sachin is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

This petition stands accepted accordingly.
