Petitioner has approached this Court alleging unnecessary harassment to herself and her family members at the hands of the official respondents as they are continuously raiding at the house of the petitioner without any warrant.

Perusal of the petition indicates that her son and daughter-in-law have been implicated in FIR No.99 dated 01.10.2017 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Noormahal, District Jalandhar and in this context, the police authorities would have been summoning or raiding the house of the petitioner.

The present petition is disposed of without going into merits of the case with observations that if the petitioner or any of her family members is required for the purpose of investigation, a proper notice under Section 160 of the Code of Criminal Procedure be sent by the Investigating Officer or concerned police official.
